XI. SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

- A** The First United Methodist Church of Mount Dora, Florida, will award a scholarship/scholarships annually as funds are available. The funds will be derived from income earned from the principal of the Scholarship Fund, together with up to one hundred percent (100%) of monies received for a special offering on the third Sunday in February. After scholarship requests have been approved, any remainder of income or offerings may be deposited to the principal of the Permanent Scholarship Fund, or be held for future scholarship requests.

Any monies contributed to Scholarship via weekly offerings will be allocated to the current year Scholarship Fund. Any bequests, unless specified otherwise, will go into the Permanent Scholarship Fund. Scholarships shall be awarded in amounts of up to \$1,500.00 per year for a four-year school, or up to \$1,000.00 for a two-year school or vocational training programs. The amount (or percentage) needed would be determined by the number of applicants and the amounts of distribution.

- B** There shall be a Scholarship Committee comprised of eight members:

Senior Pastor

The Lay Leader

Chairperson of the Work Area on Education / or designee/representative

Five members at large appointed by the Chairperson of the Church Council.

The members at large will be appointed on a three-year rotating basis.

Any member who might be related to an applicant shall be ineligible to vote or speak for the applicant. The responsibilities of the Committee shall be to review all applications, select any eligible recipients and make recommendations to the Church Council, for final approval. The Scholarship Committee may choose to make no award.

Since the third Sunday in February is designated for a special scholarship offering; it is recommended that the five (5) members at large be appointed in January of the upcoming calendar year. A planning meeting should be held prior to the February special offering. A Chairperson should be chosen for that year at the planning meeting.

- C** Application forms will be available through the Church Office. The postmark deadline for returning applications shall be no later than May 1. The Scholarship Committee will meet in early May to allow ample time to make their selection/selections and present their recommendations to the Church Council. Recipients will be notified on or before June 10.

- D** To be eligible for an award, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a full member of the First United Methodist Church of Mount Dora for at least one year and have demonstrated active or reasonable participation in some aspect of the church program.

2. The applicant is a high school graduate or a graduating senior and must have applied to or been accepted as a full-time degree candidate in an accredited college or university, two-year college, or a certified vocational program. Hereinafter referred to as "School."
3. Applicants who are high school graduating seniors and applicants who are already in college must have maintained a grade point average of 2.5 or better, on a 4.0 scale, in the last year of attendance.
4. This section weighs very heavily in your Scholarship consideration so err on the side of giving too much information rather than too little.

Your involvement in Christian activities at FUMC-MD and while attending college is one of the top priorities considered to receive a scholarship. Please fully share your areas of participation including how often you attend. Areas to be considered are: (high priority) Attend/Participate in Sunday morning worship service; participate in Christian activities sponsored by or affiliated with FUMC-MD or a campus area church or Christian organization or United Methodist Youth Fellowship. Include any offices you held. Applicant must attend one or more of these at least once per month.

Of Lesser priority, but still important, include your participation in church musical activities or United Methodist events outside the local church (camps, workshops and seminars). List any other Christian activities sponsored by or affiliated with FUMC-MD or a campus organization. Also, share any involvement you may have had in any area of community service outside the church. Use a separate sheet if necessary.

5. Applicants may reapply yearly for a grant if continuing in a degree or certificate-seeking program. The applicant is no longer eligible after four application-years.
6. In circumstances where there may be more applicants than there are funds available, applicants may need to show financial need.

E Candidates submitting their application shall include the following:

1. Church application form.
2. An official grade transcript from their respective school.

All scholarship money will be sent directly to the school. These funds will be allocated on a quarter/semester basis as required by the respective school. It is the responsibility of the recipient to advise the Committee of the name and address of the financial aid or other office where a check should be sent.

F During the semester of the scholarship grant, if the recipient forfeits the scholarship or discontinues school for any reason, the remaining or unused funds must be returned by the institution to the First United Methodist Church of Mount Dora.

G If the selected recipient should receive another scholarship, the Committee reserves the right to consider another applicant.
